FOUNDED:	1998 by Kelly Fleming; 2002 Cabernet Sauvignon was first release, in fall 2005; winery (building) opened to the public in late 2010

APPELLATION:	Calistoga
ESTATE:	300 acres in Simmons Canyon once called the Kane Ranch, encompassing steep and rocky slopes; farming also includes olive grove, apple, almond, pear, fig and plum trees; apiaries, bee hives, indigenous wildlife includes turkeys, bears
FARMING:	sustainably farmed, guided by conscientious land stewardship
VINEYARDS:	6.48 acres are planted to Cabernet Sauvignon; 4 acres were lost in the Glass Fire and have been replanted. The vines are vertical-shoot-positioned and cordon-pruned. The vineyard is nestled in Simmons Canyon on slopes that range from 5% to 30%. Farming is organic. neighbors are Eisele, Frediani, Woodbridge, Kenefick, Fisher
SOIL:	The Fleming Ranch property is composed of approximately 300 acres of mountainous terrain and located at the end of Pickett Road in Calistoga. The property is drained through Simmons Canyon which flattens and broadens into an alluvial plain at the most southern end of the property at the northern terminus of Pickett Road.
PRODUCTION:	2,000 cases All wines are estate-bottled

WINERY: 5,000 square foot winery was designed by Taylor Lombardo Architects, distinguished by use of stone in façade
Reclaimed French pavers, roof tiles and arid landscaping
Hospitality areas defined by reclaimed wooden beams, custom chandeliers, commercial kitchen
7,000 square feet of limestone caves extend 220 feet into the hillside, with 3-4,000,000 year old walls, intentionally left exposed to share their natural beauty

THE NAME: Kelly Fleming Wines is named for the proprietor, who moved to the Napa Valley from Arizona in 1999 to create her dream of a small family winery. Kelly Fleming Wines is not related to Flemings-Jenkins Vineyards.

HISTORY: Proprietor Kelly Fleming acquired the 300-acre property in 1998 and began planting vineyards in 1999. The winery opened in 2010. The winery's first release was the 2002 Cabernet Sauvignon.
